### CO-CURRICULAR PROGRAMS

Optional activities which are additional to the school curriculum are charged separately and must be paid upfront. This includes: voluntary sporting, musical and cultural groups, social activities, debating, Year 11 Semi-Formal and Year 12 Formal.

### INSTRUMENTAL AND VOCAL TUITION

All students who wish to commence private music tuition at Stuartholme School must apply and pay associated fees before the start of Term 1. Enrolment for individual instrument/voice lessons is for one full semester (two terms).

**Note:** We encourage and support student participation in co-curricula and music programs. However it is school policy that unless a payment plan is in place, term fees must be up to date prior to enrolment in these activities.

### STUARTHOLME BUILDING MAINTENANCE FUND

Parents are invited to support the School Building Maintenance Fund which addresses building repairs and maintenance programs at the School. This voluntary Fund will appear on the fee account each term and is fully tax deductible.
