*To qualify for sibling discounts, each child must attend the School at the same time. Sibling discounts apply to tuition fees only.

^If a full year's tuition fee and/or boarding fee is paid in advance by no later than 4:00pm the second Friday in December, a discount of 2.5% will apply. Please note that Incidental Charges are not included in the fees and will still need to be paid as and when they fall due.

STUARTHOLME BUILDING MAINTENANCE FUND

Parents are invited to support the School Building Maintenance Fund which addresses building repairs and maintenance programs at the School. This voluntary Fund will appear on the fee account each term and is fully tax-deductible.

STUARTHOLME SCHOOL FOUNDATION

The Stuartholme School Foundation supports future capital works at the School. The Master Plan is available on the School website. This voluntary Fund will also appear on the fee account each term and is fully tax-deductible.

Note: This is the advertised fee schedule for 2019 only. Fees are subject to an annual increase in accordance with the School Board's Budget. Fees are assessed and confirmed in the December preceding the following year (December 2019 for 2020). Parents are notified each year.

CO-CURRICULAR PROGRAMS

Optional activities which are additional to the school curriculum are charged separately and must be paid upfront. This includes: voluntary sporting, musical and cultural groups, social activities, debating, Year 11 Semi-Formal and Year 12 Formal.

INSTRUMENTAL AND VOCAL TUITION

All students who wish to commence private music tuition at Stuartholme School must apply and pay associated fees before the start of Term 1. Enrolment for individual instrument/voice lessons is for one full semester (two terms).

Note: We encourage and support student participation in co-curricula and music programs. However it is school policy that unless a payment plan is in place, term fees must be up to date prior to enrolment in these activities.

INCIDENTAL CHARGES

Incidental charges will be charged as separate items on your Fee Statement and may include:

- Boarding House recreational activities
- Transport for recreational activities and personal appointments
- Health Centre, vaccinations and pharmacy costs
- Lost or damaged textbooks, library books or laptop (not covered by warranty)
- Year 12 external exams (not compulsory).

OVERSEAS PRIVATE HEALTH COVER

All international students must be covered by Overseas Health Cover. Parents can choose to purchase Health Cover independently or select for the school to purchase this on their behalf. This can be selected during the enrolment process.

Should parents choose to purchase Overseas Health Cover via the School, the amount quoted by the Health Cover Provider is charged for each student prior to enrolment and is payable in full for the duration of the schooling.

The School will refund the pre-paid amount that is refunded by the provider if an enrolment cancellation is made prior to the commencement of the student's course. If the student leaves the School prior to the completion of the course, the parent(s)/ guardian(s) must seek a refund from the provider directly

ENROLMENT FEE & BOND

A non-refundable enrolment application fee of \$100 AUD is payable. At the time of enrolment acceptance, one term's tuition is payable as an enrolment bond. 50% of this bond is non-refundable. The remaining 50% of this bond will be refunded at the end of your daughter's enrolment with the School, provided all tuition fees and any changes have been paid in full. When a visa is refused by the Department of Immigration, the enrolment bond will be refunded in accordance with the School's Refund Policy.

ENROLMENT ACCEPTANCE FEE

When an international student is enrolled at the School, parent(s)/guardians(s) are required to pay one semester's fees in advance. This will be credited towards the fee account.

UNIFORM & STATIONERY REQUIREMENTS

Additional costs associated with uniforms and stationery are payable in the first year. Depending on your daughter's needs, these costs will vary from year to year.
