




Stuartholme BYOD Portal User Guide


This guide provides steps to purchasing a device using the Stuartholme BYOD portal hosted by JB Hi-Fi.

	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Open your browser and go to https://www.jbeducation.com.au/byod 2. In the field for 'Enter School Code' enter the code STUARTHOLME2022 3. Click on 'Start Shopping' <p>NOTE: If you have already placed an order, you can use this page to see your order history as well using the account created during the purchase process.</p>
	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. On the next page select the 'Student BYOD' Program 2. Then select the delivery option you prefer. 3. Click 'Select Device' <p>Note: Our recommendation is to select the 'School Pickup' option that way our IT department can prepare the device for your daughter before it is picked up.</p>

Add On Insurance Customer Information

The Australian Securities and Investments Commission has introduced new regulations regarding the sale of add-on insurance products. These regulations mean that there is required to be a 4 day 'pause' between the purchase of a device and any add-on insurance associated with that device.



If you nominate an add-on insurance product that you are interested in from the list below and then complete the purchase of your device, we will send you a reminder email once the 'pause' has occurred to invite you to purchase the add-on insurance product at this time.

If you proceed to pay for your device without nominating an add-on insurance product, then we will not send you any communications relating to add-on insurance unless you specifically request it by contacting us.

VERY IMPORTANT STEP!

1. On the next page you are given the option to opt in or Nominate an additional insurance option for the Accidental Protection Plan.
2. Once you nominate the policy you will then need to agree to the PDS, and you can then proceed to the next step of adding your details to the order.
3. If you nominate an add-on policy, you will receive an email with the details of the policy and then after a 4 day deferral period you will receive another email with a link to purchase the policy in a separate transaction which is a requirement as per Australian Consumer Law.

NOTE:

This additional insurance is highly recommended. This add-on insurance policy allows for a number of claims over the 3-year warranty period for any physical damage to the device such as a cracked screen etc.

If you choose to not opt in for this add-on, then any physical damage to the device not covered by the standard warranty will need to be paid for at full retail price.

As an example, the cost of a replacement screen could be up to \$1200.00 whereas this kind of incident would be covered by the add-on insurance policy.

It does not cover theft, loss, normal wear, consumables, and intentional acts of damage.

The extended warranty product provides protection against product faults and offers additional support that may not be covered by the standard manufacturer's warranty. In addition to the standard manufacturer's warranty, you may also have rights in relation to product faults under JB Hi-Fi's minimum voluntary warranty (see https://docs.shopify.com/files/1/0024/980/3/581/files/yourRights_July2014_HR_02_V07517-46c-878f-329b243feaa_0df729f726 for further details) and/or the Australian Consumer Law (see <http://www.accc.gov.au/consumers/consumer-rights-guarantees/repair-replace-refund> for further details).
